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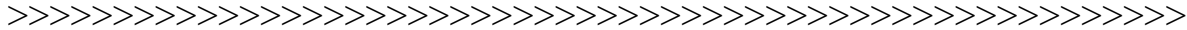
***Reservation Information for June 2<sup>nd</sup> Overnight***
